

# AUTHOR CHECKLIST

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## Manuscript title:

### General Consideration

- The article has not been published and is not otherwise submitted for publication.
- The article adheres to the ethical guidelines for research and publication.
- All persons designated as authors meet authorship criteria; designing the study, generating or gathering the data, analysis of the data, writing the paper, or critical revision of the paper.
- The use of acronyms and abbreviations is kept to a minimum and, when used, they are to be defined where first used, followed by the acronym or abbreviation in parenthesis.
- Author should write IRB approval number in the article. If the study was exempted, author should submit a exemption notification document from IRB.

### Title Page

- Title does not exceed 50 characters and 2 paragraphs for Korean title, and not exceed 20 words for English title.

### Summary and Abstract

- Summary in Korean is no longer than 800 words including blanks (in the case report, no more than 600 words).
- Abstract in English is no longer than 300 words (in the case report, no more than 150 words).
- Keywords: less than 5 words with capitalized the first letter of each word.

### References

- All References are cited and identified in the text by Arabic numerals in parenthesis.
- References are listed in the order of their citation.
- Journal names are officially abbreviated according to the Index Medicus.
- References are in proper style compatible with instructions for authors.

### Table

- The title should be a phrase, written in English and the first letter should be capitalized. The title should not end with a period.
- Each table is self-explanatory and supplement, not duplicate the text.
- For footnotes, the following symbols are used in this sequence; \*, †, ‡, §, ¶, #, \*\*, ††, ‡‡, §§, ¶¶, and # #.
- Statistical measures are identified in footnotes.

### Figures

- All images are of the highest of quality and clear enough for publication and the legend for each light microscopic images includes names of stains and magnification.
- Multiple figures under one figure number should be marked on the photographs using capital alphabet letters, at the upper left corner.
- A photo featuring a patient, whose face can be identified, should be accompanied by a written consent from the patient.

All authors have approved of the manuscript and verify that above is correct.
